Come te Jesus,

Weary and Heavy Laden

Take a piece of string and tie a knot for each thing you have been worrying about. Then spend some time praying for that thing and surrendering the control of it to Christ as you untie the knot.

• It is best to have 5, 12 inch <u>nylon ropes</u>. You could even print out <u>this reminder</u> about why we don't need to worry.

Advation

Spend some time adoring how wonderfully incredible God is. You can use the provided material to lead your heart and mind to be in awe of Him.

• The book <u>How Majestic is Thy Name</u> is great for this. If you had a few computers with connection to the internet you could use Louie Giglio's talk How Great is Our God or Mashup of Stars Singing. You can also use <u>this</u> attributes of God sheet by Bill Bright.

Ged's Passien

God's passion is for the world to know Him. Spend some time praying for the things He passionately cares about; for the world would know Him. Use the maps to lead your thinking in to things and places to pray for. Use the unreached people group cards and Operation World for specific things to pray for. Feel free to take one of the unreached people cards to keep in your Bible to pray for.

- <u>Operation World</u> or <u>Pray for the World</u> or <u>Window to the</u> <u>World</u> are great for specific prayer points for each country.
- <u>Joshua Project</u> has great printable prayer cards and specific maps about the state of the world.

God's Heart

Pray for the things close to God's heart. Orphans and oppressed. Use the magazines, newspaper and sheets to give you ideas of what they need prayer for.

 <u>Voice of the Martyrs</u> and <u>Compassion</u> have great resources. You could also print <u>Verses to Pray</u> from Missional Women. Confess and Surrender

When we made the decision to let Jesus forgive our sin and take control of our life, He forgave us for everything we have ever done in the past, present and future. So we don't confess our sin to get more forgiveness, but to restore our friendship/fellowship with God.

Ask the Lord if there is anything you need to confess and/or surrender to Him. Use the cards to help jog your thinking.

Write them down on a piece of paper and then burn it over the bowl remembering with gratitude how God has removed your sin as far as the east is from the west and will never again be remembered by Him.

- Make sure there are little pieces of paper and pens as well as a lighter and little bowl for ashes at this station.

Missien Impossible

"As the Father sent Me, I am sending you." John 20:21

Jesus' mission was to bring salvation to the lost so that they would see the Father as He truly is. This is the same mission He gives to all who receive His salvation. This is your mission. Remembering the scene from The Passion of Jesus being beaten and hung on the cross, He did this for people who may never get a chance to hear what He did for them. He gave you a very important mission to tell them.

*"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8* 

Your Jerusalem:

- 1. Make a list of the people in your sphere of influence you want to see come to know Christ and stand innocent before Him. Spend some time praying for them. (For God would soften their hearts and give them a desire to know Him and be able to see their sin for what it is etc.)
- 2. Ask God to give you ideas of how to get into a spiritual conversation with them and then share the Gospel with them. Write down the ideas that come to mind.
- You'll need paper and pens. You could print and put out <u>transition questions to the Gospel</u> from the Missional Women site.

Ged Sightings

Ask God to lead your thinking and remind you of times He has come through for you and/or shown Himself to you. Use the cards to help jog your thinking. Write down the situation(s) on a strip of paper and weave it into the loom. Spend time reading the other ways He has come through and revealed Himself and spend time praising Him.

• You can find ideas on Pinterest on how to make a loom. Then put long, narrow pieces of paper and pens on the table.



Ask God to help you see the things He has blessed you with and write them down and hang them on the thanksgiving tree.

• You'll need little pieces of paper with a hole punched in it that a small string can fit through. A branch off a tree in a vase held with big rocks works well to hang it on.

Hearing from the Lord

As a way to hear from and connect with the Lord, open your journal and complete the first chapter. Then pick one thing that encouraged you and write it on the canvas.

 You can order journals from the <u>Missional Women store</u>. You'll need to put a couple Bibles and pens. You can use a poster, <u>canvas</u> or even something like a <u>scroll</u>.

Identity

"How precious are your thoughts about me, O God. They cannot be numbered! I can't even count them; they outnumber the grains of sand!" Psalm 139:17-18

Count as many grains of sand as you can and think about God's thoughts toward you. Then spend some time reading through the verses that talk about your identity in Christ and spend some time thanking Him.

 It works best to place a little bit of <u>sand</u> on a black surface (chalkboard or construction paper). You'll also need to print out Scripture that talks about our identity in Christ. I use <u>these</u>.
